FACTS ON JAMADA AL-AWWAL AND JAMADA AL-AKHIRA

Both these months have no special rules, nor are there any specific customs practiced by the Muslim people in these months.

'Al-Ayyam ul-Beed' - Fast the White days of each month

- Qatadah bin Milhan رضى الله عنه reported: The Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم directed us to observe Saum (fasting) on the thirteenth, fourteenth and fifteenth of the (lunar) month.

- Ibn `Abbas رضى الله عنهما reported: It was the practice of the Messenger of Allah صلى الله عليه وسلم to not to omit fast on the 'bright days' whether he was staying at a place or on a journey.

Many feel that fasting is only restricted to Ramadan, but that is not so. Fasting in general and voluntary fasting in particular is a great act of worship. It can be [and should be in some cases] performed at any time and at any place except when not recommended.
